Prevention measures for ARTISTS' FAIR KYOTO 2022

The ARTISTS' FAIR KYOTO 2022 will be held abiding to the guidelines of the Japanese government, Kyoto prefecture and other related domestic organisations, in taking measures to prevent COVID-19 (coronavirus) from spreading so that you may safely enjoy the event.

Please check the following points before coming to the venue, and we ask for your co-operation.

- 1. Entry will be restricted to reservations made online in advance, to maintain enough distancing to avoid close-contact.
- 2. Following the guidelines created by the Japanese government, we ask for your prior consent that we are required to register your name, contact details, date and time of visit for each venue, in the case that we need to take quick actions to prevent the further spread should there be any person found to be infected, and that we may need to provide this information to the health center and or other official bodies of the Japanese government as necessary.
- 3. We ask for your prior understanding that depending on the situation of the spread of COVID-19, there is a possibility that the event will be postponed or cancelled without prior announcement.

Notice to all visitors

- 1. Please check your temperature before coming to our venues, and refrain from coming should any of the following apply.
- Your temperature is higher than usual (as a guide, we will not permit those with a temperature higher than 37.5°C).
- You have a cough or sore throat.
- You have had close-contact with a person tested positive with COVID-19.
- You have had close-contact in the past two weeks with a person who has travelled to a country or area, which immigration is restricted by the Japanese government, or requires quarantine after immigration, or is a resident of such country or area.
- 2. Please be sure to wear a mask inside the venue, and cover your mouth and nose when you cough or sneeze. (We will not permit entry to those without a mask.)
- 3. For those of you with a smartphone, please pre-install a coronavirus

- contact-tracing app that is supported in Japan.
- 4. Please maintain your distance with others inside the venue while watching to avoid close-contact, and do not speak in a loud voice. Food and drinks are not permitted inside the venue.

Prevention measures to be taken by artists, assistants and staff members

Staff members including reception, guides and supervisors are to take the following measures.

- 1. Wear a mask (artists are to wear a face shield), and carry a sanitiser.
- 2. Those with a temperature over 37.5°C are not to attend.
- 3. Staff members are to track their temperature from two weeks before the event.
- 4. Keep track of contact details in the case of an emergency.

In addition to the above, the venue will be ventilated, and open areas such as handrails will be sanitised regularly.
